

Students Not Returning:

The first thing to say is the school is fully accepting of the whole host of reasons why parents and students may have come to the decision not to return to school. We respect your decision as parents and students. If you make this decision you are not left alone.

All year groups

Clearly Y7, Y8, Y9 are not returning as yet. In terms of their provision, students are engaging with their subjects and are working well. Some have, and will continue to need, assistance from subject staff and pastoral support calls to check on wellbeing.

All students will have at least one phone call home by the end of term to check on wellbeing and progress with the work being set on Teams and any catch up work they will need to complete before September.

Year 10 and 12

Those students unable to return will have a phone call to check on their wellbeing and their progress with the work. Depending upon how they are, this could be as much as weekly or as little as once before the Summer

Year 7 and 12 Transition

We will not be able to run our normal interactive 'Transition Days' for Year 7 or Year 12 in the usual way. There will instead be a virtual transition process online. Year 11 into 12 have already commenced their transition work, whilst the Year 6 into 7 transition process will commence at the beginning of July.
