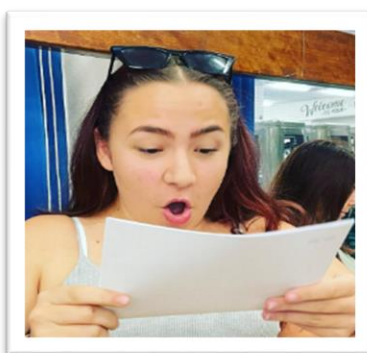


It has been another superb year for Year 11 at Fort Pitt, with students securing excellent results. In the benchmark Progress 8 measure, the school expects to achieve around +0.5, meaning that on average students have achieved half a grade better than expected in each of their subjects.

Nearly 50% of grades awarded were at 9-7 and 85% of grades at 5+.
