Top tips for students



- Knowledge is not enough.
- You must also spend time developing your skills, such as calculations and 'chunking' case studies for application (AO2). You must use the case studies provided.
- You must be 100% confident with what exam structure is required for every question type so as not to lose easy marks or run out of time.
- Practice writing under timed conditions.
- With 3 mark questions, if in doubt include an example or a 'However, it depends on....'
